First came "Victoria Regia", now "Burgundy Evening". The sensual fragrance of Amber Romance, fragrant carmine red roses and wine created a blend that evokes a romantic evening with someone you love. I can imagine how nice candles, body butters or even bath salts will smell scented with this fragrance.

Cupid's Kiss

5 parts OT [Angel](#)

3 parts OT [Chocolate Truffle](#)

1 part OT [Summer Strawberry](#)

Luscious plump and ripe heart shaped strawberries covered with the most delicious and sweet chocolate surrounds the regal and romantic Angel fragrance. This fragrance is sweet and sensual at the same time, like innocence and passion combined. This is the kind of scent that should be in lotions, creams and body butters, but should be wonderful in other products as well.

1 part OT [Absolutely Awesome Oakmoss](#)

Well, I'll let the description about how this one smells to your imagination, but this simple and very masculine blend of the sexiest oakmoss on earth with the fresh herbal scent of lemongrass and sage, definitely calls for a complete line of products for all your man needs.

Egyptian Moon Goddess

2 parts OT [Egyptian Musk](#)

1 part OT [Jasmine](#)

The captivating fragrance of night blooming jasmine flowers mingles with the warm regal fragrance of Egyptian musk for an exotic oriental fragrance of a mysterious quality that is haunting and sexy at same time.

Antique Carnations

4 parts OT [Gee Your Hair Smells Terrific](#)

1 parts OT [Spicy](#)

1 part OT [Black Pepper fragrance oil](#)

This is a variation of a carnation blend I did some time ago, with a slight change in the proportion of the fragrance components and with the addition of Black Pepper fragrance oil for more warmth, depth and authenticity .This unisex spicy floral blend is reminiscent of the wonderful scent of antique spicy clove pink carnations, a scent that unfortunately is missing in the new carnation varieties we have today. You'll love this carnation blend!

Note: For a fresh cut carnation scent with a slight green "stem" note, you can add 1 part of OT's Cutting Garden.

Romance in Paradise

The following blend couple is quite complex, but definitely worth trying. They're two blends that I've wanted to do for a long time. I love the tropics and all those elements that make me think of it in all its beauty. The heady sweetness of tropical flowers, juicy fruit nectars, exotic spices, woods and resins join together to create two exotic fragrances that will make you dream about a romantic vacation in a far away island paradise.

Women's version

This is a sweet tropical blend with the exotic scent of the Tahitian Tiare flower as one of the main notes. Imagine a white floral paradise of Tahitian gardenias, fragrant flowers and luscious fruits, warmed by amber and exotic musks and kissed with delicate coconut notes and spice. I absolutely love this one!, it reminds me of the fragrance of a variety of plumeria I have growing in my backyard that doesn't smell like any of those fantasy plumeria scents out there. Absolutely gorgeous!

Men's Version

This sexy spicy masculine blend have a lovely arrangement of exotic tropical spices and woods, tied up with the green and fresh Green Irish Tweed fragrance and warmed up with Amber Romance. It has the scents of the tropical rainforest together in a masculine blend. Cedarwood essential oil added a wonderful woody depth to this blend very similar to sandalwood essential oil. **Note:** You can substitute "Amber Dawn" for the "Amber Romance" in this blend.

Be sure to add the following fragrances to your Oregon Trail Fragrance oil arsenal:

[Green Irish Tweed" Creed type](#) - I so wanted this men's fragrance to be in the Oregon Trail line, but a really good one, not a cheap imitation and now Oregon Trail's got it! It's a DEAD ON DUPE of the expensive perfume of the same name. This majestic fragrance was originally created by the House of Creed for actor Cary Grant and it's a favorite of Prince Charles and many actors like Richard Gere, Nicolas Cage and Robert Redford. It's also a favorite of many women. It has notes

of mysore sandalwood, ambergris, violet leaves, French verbena and Florentine iris. It's very fresh and it is AWESOME in CP soap.

Tiare Blossoms - The exotic and heady tropical fragrance of monoi that many of us love!. It's very difficult to find the elusive scent of the Tahitian gardenia or Tiare (*Gardenia taitensis*), but fortunately Oregon Trail got a version that is fantastic and sticks like glue in CP soap. The scent of Tahitian gardenias is a very sweet floral, similar to the scent of the common corsage gardenia and tuberose with light warm spicy notes. It's paradise in a bottle!

Black Pepper: Black Pepper meets Chai Tea. Wow! This is a fragrance I would never have thought would be SO GOOD in a fragrance oil. True black pepper essential oil is very strong and pungent, but not this FO. It has a top note black pepper (of course!), but softened by a very warm spice background of cinnamon, nutmeg, cardamom and a slight hint of vanilla absolute that adds an interesting appeal to the fragrance oil. This one became an instant favorite of mine. It's wonderful by itself, but amazing in blends as well.
